Title: Vocational Mentor- Auto Repair

Reports to: Operations Director

Status: Full Time, Non-Exempt

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Vocational Mentor / Instructor is responsible for instructing and training Project LIFT participants to help them achieve their vocational goals, as well as providing transportation to and from school and/or home, if needed.

SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Coordinate Fleet Vehicle maintenance and repairs for Project Lift Vehicles.
- Certify participants in ALLDATA repair using instructor manual and hands on techniques.
- Complete 1 large specialty project / year (hot rod rebuild).
- Plan/complete small projects with participants.
- Attend and actively engage in daily meetings.
- Instruct and monitor Project LIFT participants in the use and care of equipment and materials, in order to prevent injuries and damage.
- Instruct and mentor Project LIFT participants individually, and in groups.
- Establish clear objectives for all projects and communicate those objectives to Project LIFT participants.
- Enforce rules of behavior for Project LIFT participants.
- Prepare materials for projects and activities.
- Handle reporting and record keeping as necessary and/or required.
- Work efficiently and effectively without supervision.
- Assists the operations director and provide support where needed.
- Pick up or drop off children depending on the need each day.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Minimum of 2 years of relevant experience.
- Maintain high level of confidentiality.
- Able to determine work priorities and ensure proper completion of work assignments.
- Uphold professional standards and represent mission and values of Project LIFT in public.

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY/WORKING CONDITIONS

- Able to lift up to minimum of 25lbs.
- Able to work in non-air conditioned environment.
- Able to stay on feet for extended periods of time.
